Discover the beauties of Brazil in a unique way, the beautiful dunes of Lencois and the charms of nature in the Amazon.



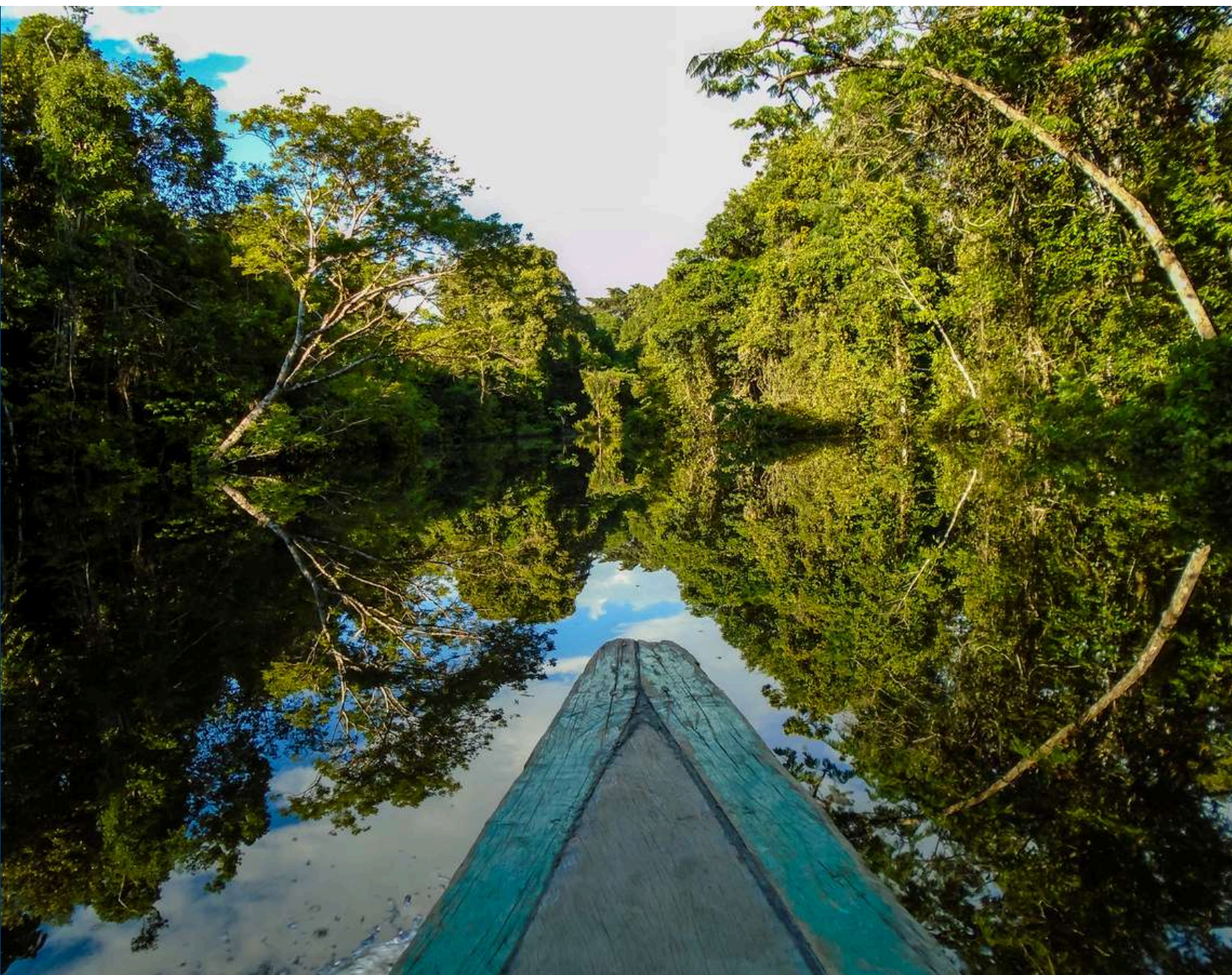
LENÇÓIS MARANHENSES



Nature was very generous in creating the Lençóis Maranhenses, which could easily be called paradise. The Maranhenses dunes and crystal-clear lagoons possess a surreal beauty that leaves any visitor speechless. And the attractions do not end here: the region also has delightful rivers for swimming or sailing, beautiful sandbank vegetation and even beaches with beautiful landscapes.

AMAZON

Amazon rainforest covers an area of more than 5 million square kilometers of which 80% is on Brazilian territory. Amazon corresponds to 41% of the European territory, less than half of this continent. It is the largest and most intact rainforest region in the world.



Program - 08 Days and 07 Nights

Day 1 - Sao Luis / Barreirinhas

Disembark at São Luís airport for a flight to report, board an air-conditioned vehicle heading to the city of Barreirinhas (Entrance to Lençóis Maranhenses National Park). The route is about 260 km with an average duration of 04 hours and a quick stop in the city of Morros for toilets and coffee (not included).

Overnight at Porto Preguicas Resort Meals: --

Day 2 - Lençois Maranhenses (Gran Lençois - Laguna Azul or Laguna Estacional)

Breakfast at the hotel. At 2:00 pm, departure by 4x4 van to the Lençois circuit. Ferry crossing over the Preguiças River and continuing along the trail to the stopping point (about 40 minutes of walking). Disembark and start a light walk through the white dunes and visit the lagoons available at the station with stops for swimming and contemplation of the beautiful landscape with appreciation of the sunset. Return to the vehicle by the same route back to the hotel. Free night and accommodation.

Overnight at Porto Preguicas Resort Meals: Breakfast included

Day 3 - Little Lençois

Breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast, around 8:30, departure from the hotel to the pier on Avenida Beira Rio and boarding a motorboat for the Rio Preguiças Circuit (APA - Environmental Protection Area). During the tour you can appreciate the typical vegetation of the mangroves and the fauna of the region surrounding the river. The first stop is in the community of Vassouras, a place where you can find the small mangroves and a small community of riverside dwellers and clawed monkeys that live there and interact with the visitor. Continue to Mandacaru, a small village that houses the Preguiças Lighthouse with 160 steps to enjoy a 360° view of the region with dunes, river, estuary, typical vegetation and the city. Finally, Cabure, a beach that is divided between the river and the sea. Stop for lunch (not included). After 3:00 pm, departure by speedboat passing through the river's igarapés to Barreirinhas. Transfer to the hotel. Free night and accommodation.

Overnight at Porto Preguicas Resort Meals: Breakfast included

Day 4 - Barreirinhas / Sao Luis / Manaus

Breakfast at the hotel. Free morning. At the agreed time, board an air-conditioned vehicle to São Luís airport, which takes approximately 4 hours.

Flight to Manaus (not included)

Arrival in Manaus and transfer to the hotel in Manaus

Overnight at Villa Amazonia Hotel Meals: Breakfast included

Day 5 - Manaus / Amazonas (Gavião Lodge Viewpoint)

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer from Manaus to Novo Airão (2:30h - 200 km) by air-conditioned transport. Lunch at the Camu-Camu restaurant. City tour in Novo Airão, with a tour guide, which can be done with the hotel's bicycles or by motor vehicle. Optional activity in the afternoon: Lecture on the Amazonian ecosystem of the Rio Negro. Dinner at the Camu-Camu restaurant.

At night: sighting of alligators and other nocturnal animals in the Anavilhanas archipelago, by speedboat.

Overnight at Mirante do Gavião Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner included

Day 6 - Madada Caves / Giant Trees

Breakfast at the Camu-Camu Restaurant. In the morning, departure by speedboat (1h30) for the interpretive trail to the Madadá Caves (full day - 3 hours of trekking in primary forest). Lunch at the Madadá Belvedere with a view of the Anavilhanas Archipelago. Leisure and contemplation in the hammocks at the Mirador. Return by speedboat to the Lodge (1h30), through the Anavilhanas Islands, stops to see giant trees and flooded forest, and possible movements of fauna. Dinner at the Camu-Camu Restaurant.

Optional included: Spotting alligators and other nocturnal animals in the Anavilhanas Archipelago, by speedboat.

Overnight at Mirante do Gavião Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner included

Day 7 - Sunrise / Canoe / Piranha Fishing

Departure before breakfast to watch the sunrise over the Anavilhanas Archipelago. Return for breakfast. After breakfast, departure in the morning by speedboat for canoeing in Igarapé de Castanheira. Return for lunch with a stop at freshwater beaches (in dry season) or for water trails through Igapós - Flooded Forest (in flood season). Lunch at the Camu-Camu Restaurant. After lunch, free time to rest and enjoy the inn's play areas. At the end of the afternoon, departure by speedboat for piranha fishing. Dinner at the Camu-Camu Restaurant.

Optional included: Spotting alligators and other nocturnal animals in the Anavilhanas Archipelago, by speedboat.

Overnight at Mirante do Gavião Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner included

Day 8 - Tiririca Community / Pirarucus / Manaus

Breakfast at the Camu-Camu Restaurant. Departure by speedboat to visit the riverside community of Tiririca (40 min), return to visit the Pink Dolphins' floating house. Return for lunch at the Lodge. Transfer from Novo Airão to Manaus (2:30 hours) with a stop to visit the Mangueirão Baths with pirarucus nursery.

Arrival at Manaus airport to take the flight back home.

Meals: Breakfast and lunch

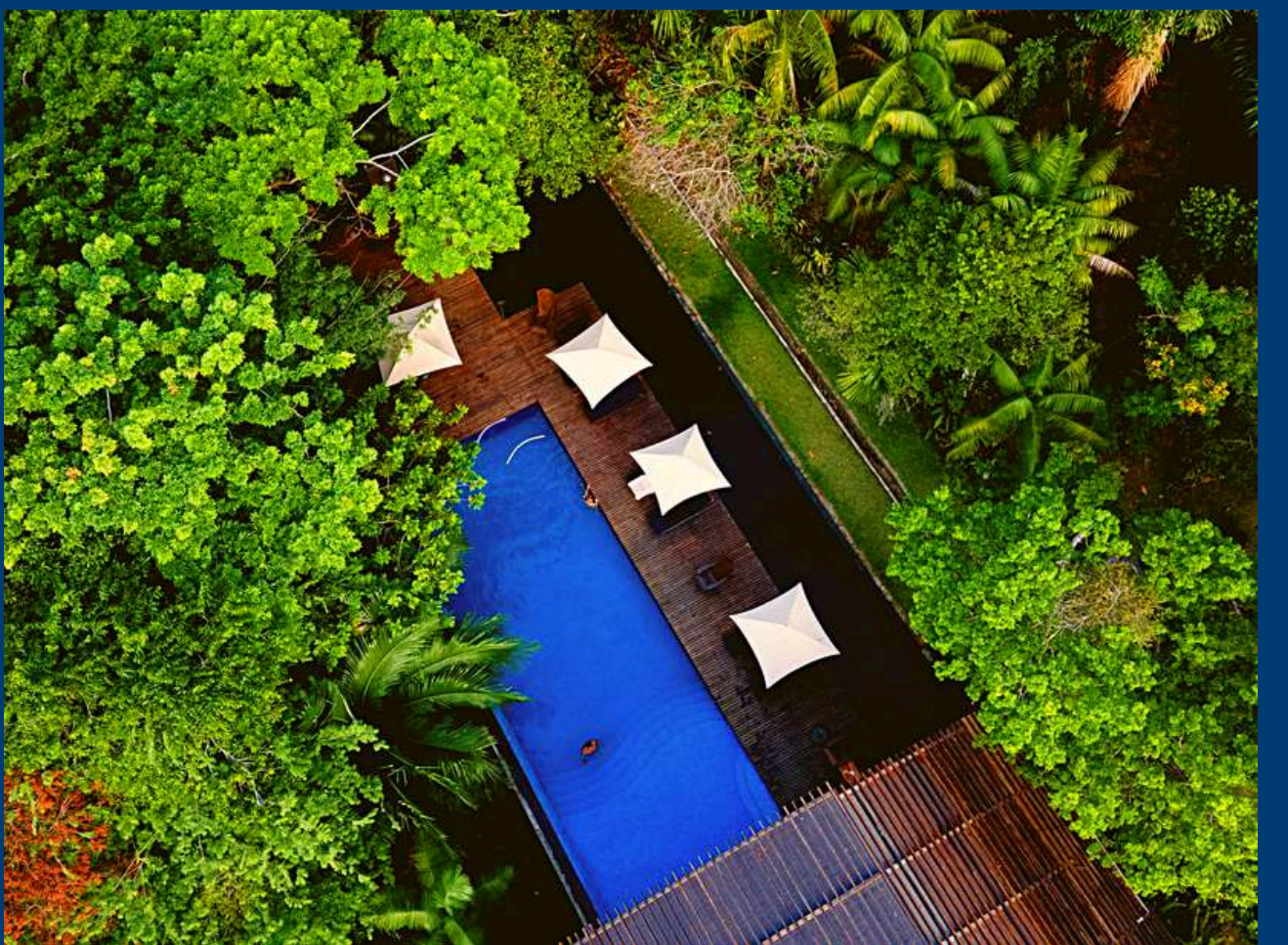
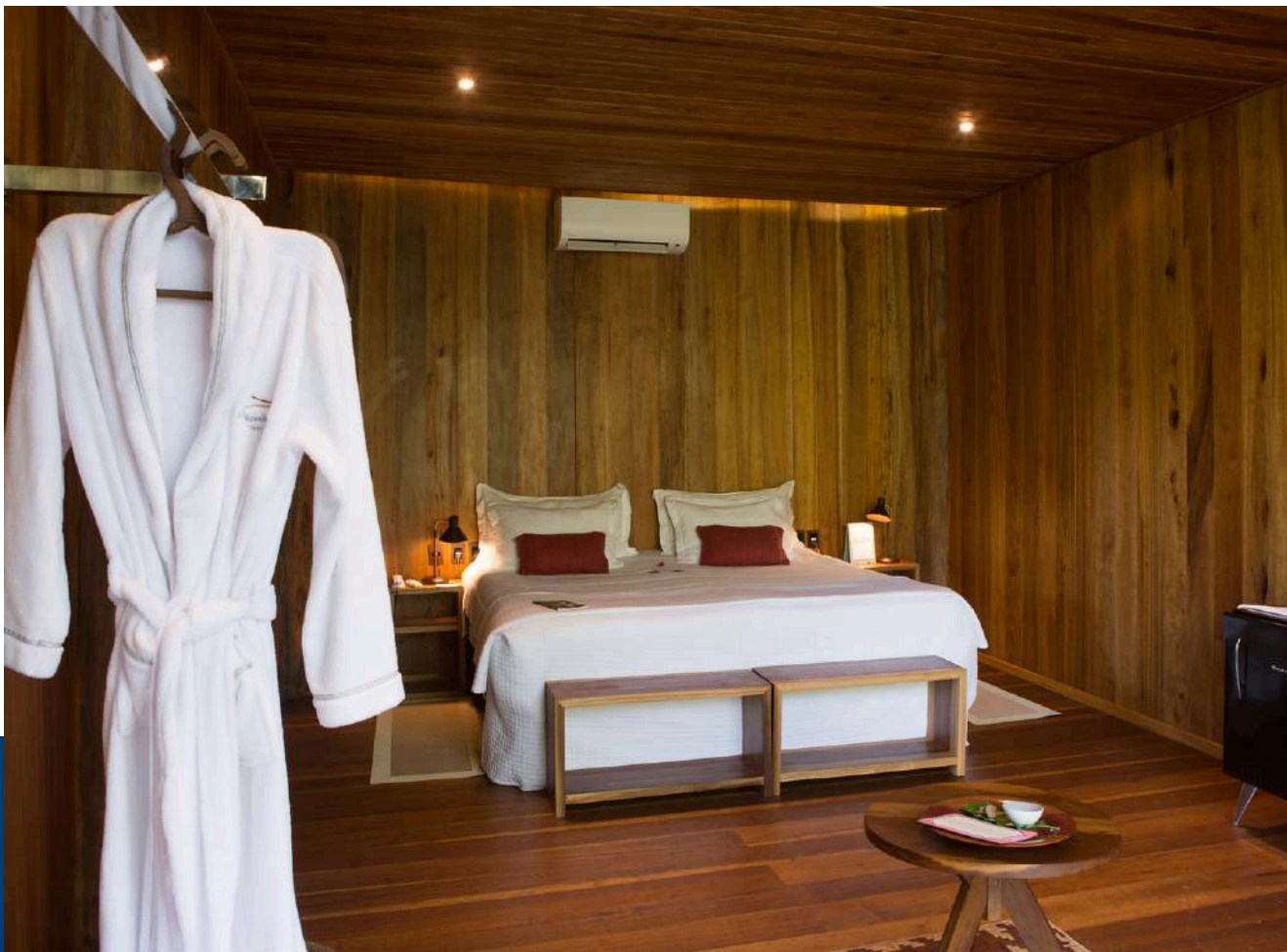

Mirante do Gavião

The lodge is located about 3 hours from Manaus, at the end of the road, on the edge of the border town of Novo Airão. Facing the Anavilhanas Archipelago National Park on the Negro River, the property is perfectly situated to take advantage of the hundreds of unspoiled islands in the dark waters of the Negro River. The pH balance of the water inhibits insect proliferation, so mosquitoes are less common. The accommodations are surrounded by Brazilian walnut trees, tucumã palms and other trees native to the Amazon biome, as well as the beautiful view of the Anavilhanas Archipelago.



Those who live in the Great Amazon Plain feel the absence of local highlands to observe the immensity of the forest and its great rivers. The Mirante do Gavião Amazon Lodge offers in its leisure areas a swimming pool, pier, lounge and restaurant, and some viewing points on the property where you can relax and enjoy the various types of view: Rio Negro, Anavilhanas Archipelago, our birds or even the friendly sloths and iguanas of our small forest.
